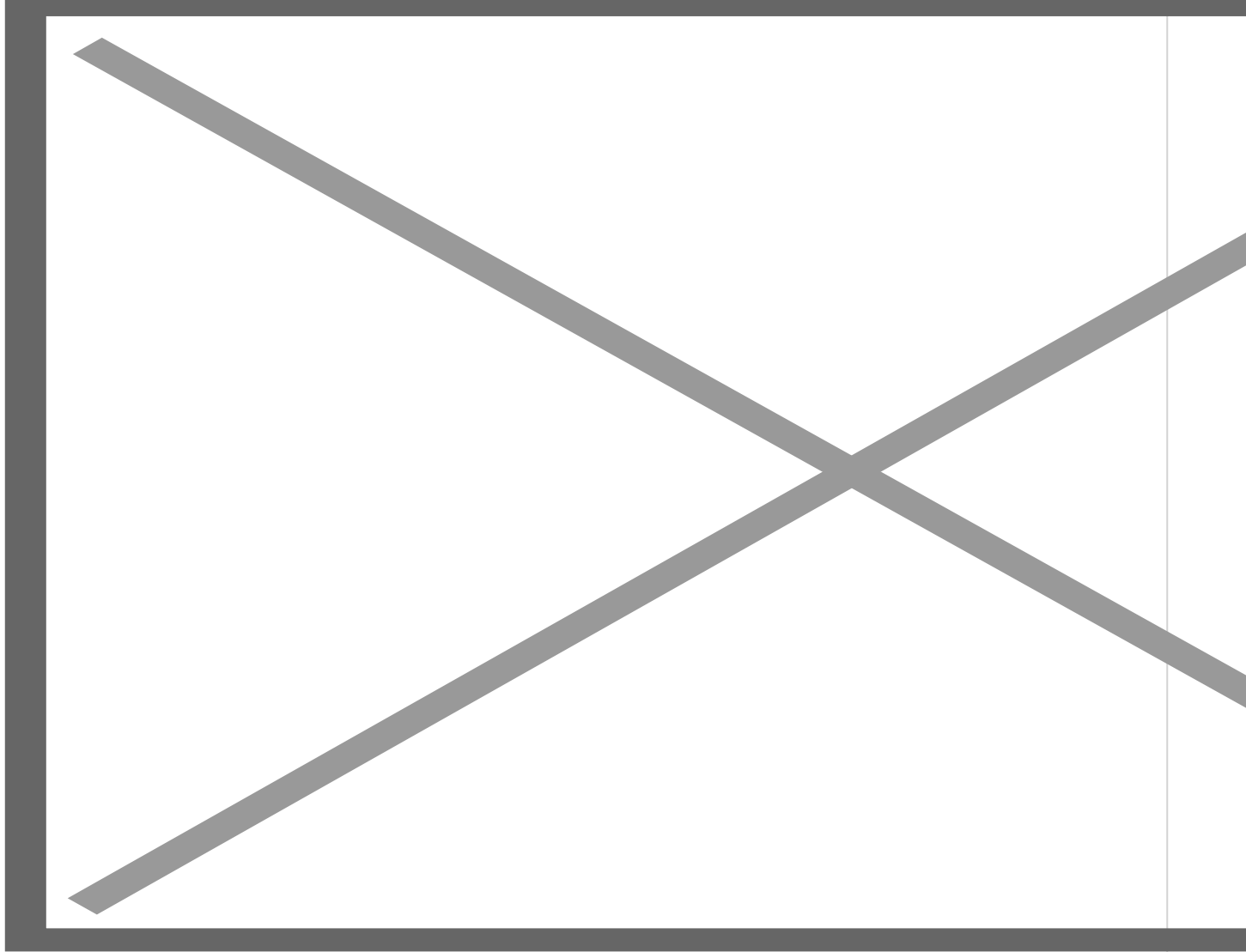


Venezuelan president invites left-wing movements to join the Anti-Fascist International
