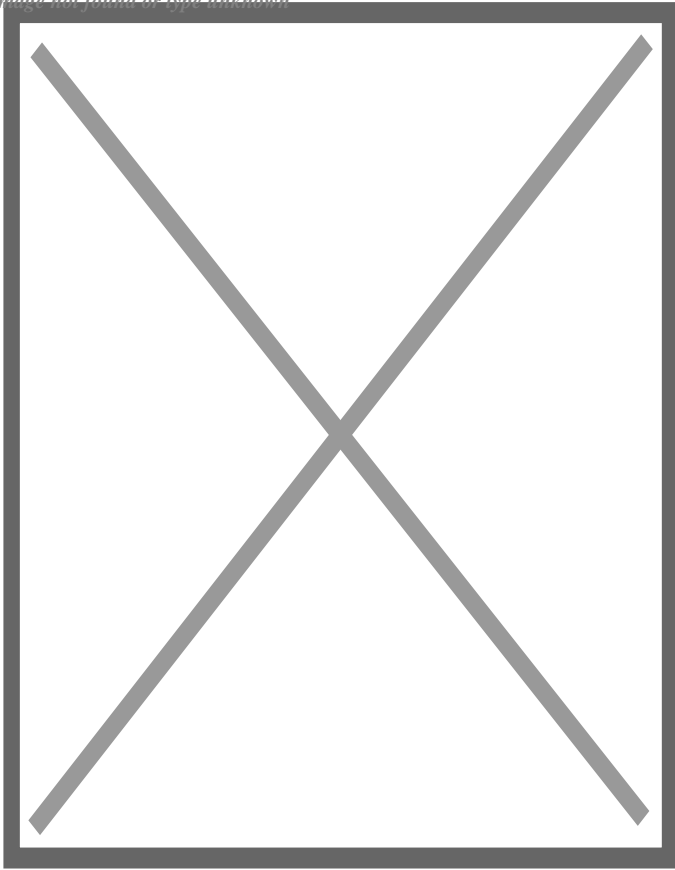


Israeli siege in northern Gaza continues as Netanyahu considers genocidal policy called Surrender or Starve

Tel Aviv, October 15 (RHC)-- In the wake of the recent Israeli strikes on the Jabaliya refugee camp in the northern Gaza Strip, killing at least 20 people and injured dozens, the Zionist war machine continues its relentless massacres.

Israel's intensifying attacks on northern Gaza come as Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu is considering implementing a "surrender or starve" policy in the area.

Earlier, Doctors Without Borders said thousands of residents are trapped in Jabaliya. The group said: "Nobody is allowed to get in or out. Anyone who tries is getting shot." One Palestinian diplomat, Majed Banya, decried the Israeli siege, saying: "What is happening in northern Gaza now is a genocide within the genocide."
