Statement from the Union of Cuban Journalists



At the start of his new presidential term, Donald Trump has displayed the criminal attitude that he already displayed in the previous one. Without any moral or legal basis, his impudence has been displayed on international levels with the media spectacularity of an egotistical magnate and convicted criminal. Against Cuba in particular, the "Republican" resumes the cruelty with which he had already reinforced the blockade with extreme measures that his "democratic" predecessor maintained despite promises for electoral purposes.
