Elon Musk hypes up Germany's neo-Nazi AfD party ahead of February election



Berlin, January 27 (RHC)-- In news from Germany, the world's richest man, Elon Musk, took a break from advising Donald Trump on Saturday to give a surprise virtual address to the far-right party AfD, or Alternative for Germany.

Musk's appearance came just days after he sparked controversy for twice giving a Nazi salute at a Trump inaugural event. Among other things, Musk told attendees it's time to "move on" from "past guilt," an apparent reference to Nazism and the Holocaust.

Elon Musk said: "Well, first of all, I wanted to really say that I'm very excited for the AfD. ... It's good to be proud of German culture and German values and not to lose that in some sort of multiculturalism that dilutes everything."
