Israeli drones attacking Gaza civilians in north and south

Rafah, March 30 (RHC)-- Reports from southern Gaza affirm that armed Israeli attack drones are targetting civilians in both the northern and southern regions of the besieged Gaza Strip. According to eye-witnesses, drones have been buzzing incessantly above hospital in Rafah.

Attack drones hit a community kitchen where people gathered for food in the Sujayea neighbourhood on Saturday. Family members of those wounded were seen running into the hospital to check if their loved

ones are still alive. Three people are in critical condition in the operating theatre.

One foreign correspondent reporting on the attacks said that "shredded bodies" were loaded onto a cart and brought to the emergency room of Al-Ahli Hospital.

In southern Khan Younis, an Israeli drone attacked an animal-drawn cart and four people were killed on the spot. Another attack on a tent in the city's east wounded several more.
