
Trinidad and Tobago Parliamentary Delegation to Visit Cuba



Port of Spain, February 5 (RHC) — In news from Trinidad and Tobago, House Speaker Wade Mark is expected to lead a Trinitarian parliamentary delegation on a visit to Cuba, cabinet sources announced.
