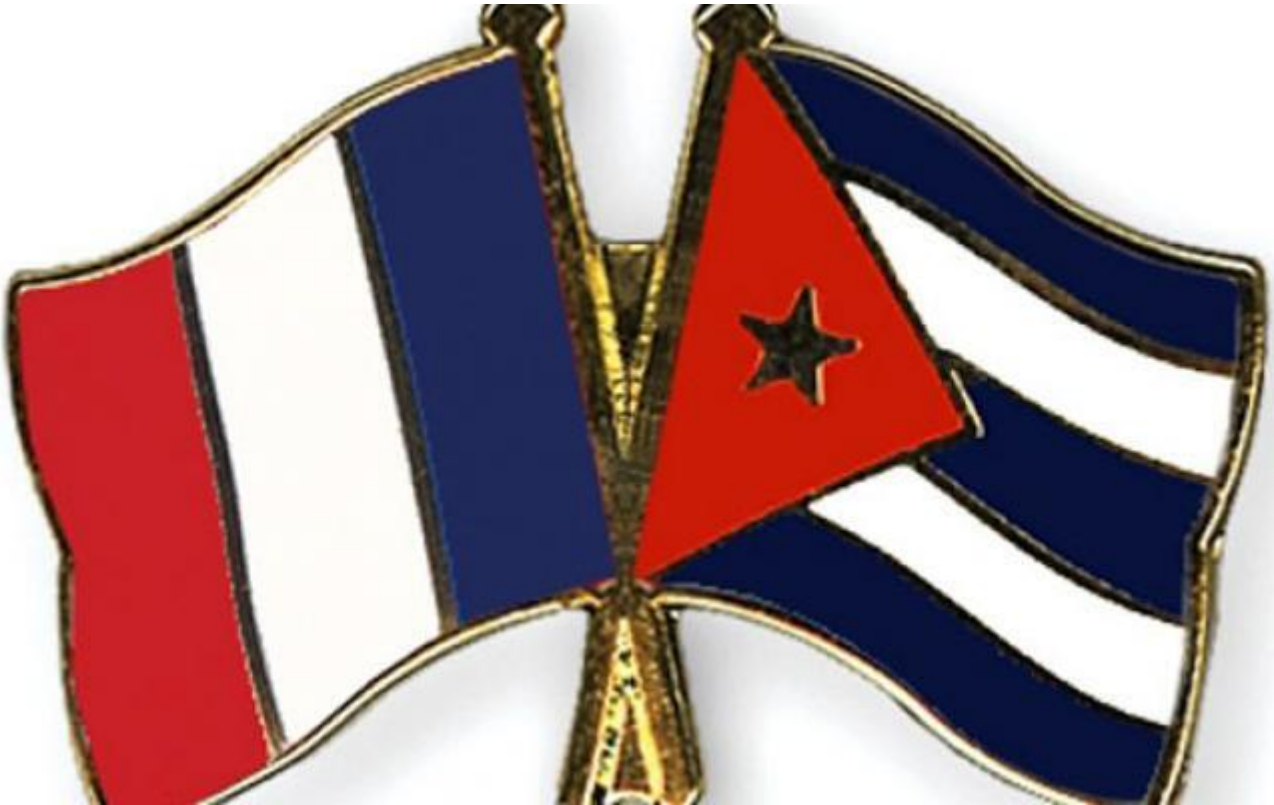


France to Strengthen Cooperation Relations with Cuba



Havana, Mar 7, (RHC), — France's State Secretary for Foreign Trade, Tourism and the Diaspora, Matthias Fekl said in Havana that his country is interested in strengthening cooperation and commercial relations with Cuba.

The top government French official, who is visiting the island, told reporters that he has held working meetings with Cuban authorities from the ministries of Foreign Trade and Investment, Foreign Relations, Tourism and Agriculture.

In these meetings, said Fekl, the French entrepreneurs that are accompanying him exchanged views about the sectors they are interested in developing commercial relations with.
