Cuba Supports Chemical Weapons Ban



The Hague, April 29 (RHC) — Cuban Foreign Minister Bruno Rodriguez has paid a visit to the Organization for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW) and met with Director General Ambassador Ahmet Üzümcü to discuss issues related to the implementation of the Chemical Weapons Convention (CWC).
