North Dakota Town Evacuated after Oil Train Derails



Bismarck, May 7 (RHC)-- A North Dakota town was evacuated Wednesday following the derailment of a train carrying crude oil. About 40 residents were forced to leave Heimdal as emergency crews responded to the fire.

It was at least the sixth accident this year involving so-called "bomb trains" transporting crude oil through North American communities. The accident comes just days after U.S. federal regulators released longawaited new standards for the trains, which environmentalists have criticized as insufficient.
