

Russia and Cuba Consider Nuclear Energy Cooperation



Moscow, June 2 (RHC-AGENCIAS) — The president of Russia's Rosatom Corporation, Serguei Kirienko, and Cuban Science Minister Elba Rosa Perez considered in Moscow opportunities for bilateral cooperation in the nuclear energy field.
