CELAC Analyzes Political Mission to Verify Definitive Ceasefire in Colombia



New York, February 8 (RHC)-- The Community of Latin American and Caribbean States (CELAC) is currently analyzing details to set up a political mission to verify the definitive ceasefire in Colombia, once it is implemented by the government of President Juan Manuel Santos and the Revolutionary Armed Forces of Colombia-People's Army (FARC-EP).
