

Nicaragua Honors General Sandino on the Anniversary of his Murder



Managua, February 22 (RHC)-- Nicaraguan President Daniel Ortega paid homage to National Hero, General Augusto César Sandino, on the 82nd anniversary of his murder.

At the event held at the Sandino's birthplace, Ortega stressed that the national hero died fighting for peace in Nicaragua.

The President talked on the new historic cycle that began on January 10, 2007, with the return of the Sandinistas to power and the process to build unity among Nicaraguans.
