

Famous Prado Museum paintings exhibited in Old Havana



Fifty three copies of the most emblematic works at the Museum of Prado in Madrid, Spain, are on display at Old Havana's Royal Force Castle.

Thousands of Cubans and international visitors have been able to watch the exhibition hung from the Royal Force Castle's iron fences.
