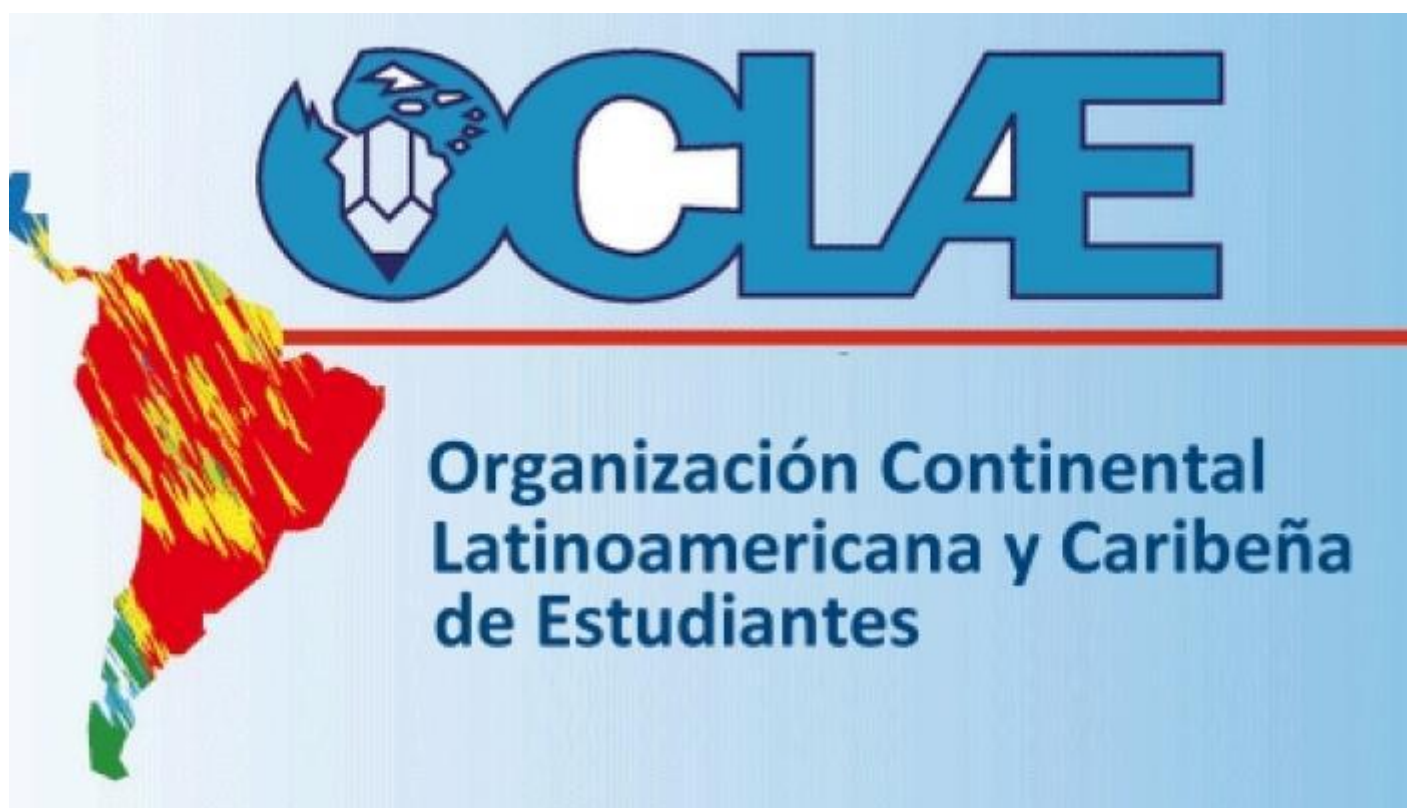


Havana to Host Meeting of Continental Association of Latin American and Caribbean Students
