

Cuban Economy Minister Receives Counterpart from United Arab Emirates



Havana, November 22 (RHC)-- Cuba's Economy Minister Ricardo Cabrisas, met Monday in Havana with his counterpart from the United Arab Emirates, Sultan Bin Saeed Al Mansouri.
