

North Korea Declares Three Days of Mourning for Fidel Castro



Havana, November 28 (RHC)- North Korea has declared three days of mourning, beginning Monday November 28th, for Revolution leader Fidel Castro, who maintained close relations with the Asian country.

North Korea's daily Rodong reported that it was a joint decision adopted by the Workers Party, the country's Parliament and government.
