

Cuban Ambassador in Kazakhstan Signs Condolence Book for Death of Former Iranian President

Astana, January 12 (RHC)-- Cuba's ambassador to Kazakhstan Carlos Valdés signed the book of condolences at the Iranian diplomatic mission in Astana, the Kazakh capital, for the death of former Iranian President Ali Akbar Hashemi Rafsanjani.

He was buried at Mausoleum of Ruhollah Khomeini, which holds the remains of the founding father of the Persian nation.
