Cuban and Portuguese Foreign Ministers Hold Official Talks in Lisbon



Lisbon, April 20 (RHC)-- Cuban Foreign Minister Bruno Rodríguez and Portuguese Foreign Affairs Minister Augusto Santos Silva reviewed the state of bilateral relations during a meeting at the headquarters of the Foreign Ministry in Lisbon.
