President Raúl Castro Receives Leader of Revolutionary Armed Forces of Colombia



Havana, May 29 (RHC)-- Cuban President Raúl Castro met Sunday in Havana with the top commander of the Revolutionary Armed Forces of Colombia (FARC) Timoleón Jiménez.
