

First Vice President Miguel Díez-Canel Receives Dominican Republic's Attorney General



Havana, September 21 (RHC)-- Cuba's First Vice President Miguel Díaz-Canel Bermúdez received in Havana the Attorney General of the Dominican Republic, Jean Alain Rodríguez. Through the Attorney General, Díez-Canel thanked the government and people of the neighboring country for their solidarity following the devastation caused by Hurricane Irma.
