

White House Says 16 Women Accusing Trump of Sex Crimes are Liars



Washington, October 30 (RHC)-- The White House has confirmed that its official position is that all 16 women who have accused President Donald Trump of sexual misconduct are lying.

White House Press Secretary Sarah Huckabee Sanders, answering questions from reporters, said that the president has been "clear from the beginning." She claimed that all the accusations were "fake news" and that the 16 women charging him with sexually harassing them throughout the course of the presidential campaign were lying.

Meanwhile, more women have come forward to accuse former U.S. President George H.W. Bush of sexual assault, bringing the number of his accusers to five. Among them is former Maine Senate candidate Amanda Staples, who said on Instagram that Bush groped her in 2005 as she posed for a photo with the former president.
