Cuba and Egypt Prepare Joint Culture Festival



Havana, February 26 (RHC)-- A Cultural Festival will be held in Cairo in the second trimester of this year, as part of a joint plan between Cuba and Egypt.

The coordination of the festival was agreed during a meeting between Cuba's ambassador to that Arab nation, Otto Vaillant, and Egyptian Deputy Culture Minister Camila Sobhi, in which the good state of cultural relations was analyzed.
