Brazilian Daily Highlights Work of Cuban Doctors



Porto Alegre, February 27 (RHC) The work of the Cuban doctors in Brazil and their impact on the medical sector and the population was the focus of a report published by the Zero Hora daily of Brazilian state of Porto Alegre.

They are few, but they are deeply changing the habitual performance of medical professionals and the doctor-patient relations in Rio Grande do Sul, reads the article which, under the title "Cuban Revolution at Health Care Centers," describes the routine of a group of Cuban physicians in the South American nation. The doctors, who came to join the More Doctors Program, are simple persons, clean their homes, carry their lunch with them; they are committed to their patients and systematic and like going partying like we Brazilians do. With all this they are breaking the barriers of prejudice and the corporate-oriented behavior of Brazilian professionals, the article reads.

This was the first report by the Brazilian media about the Cuban doctors currently offering their services in the South American country.
