

Cuban foreign minister meets with visiting chairman of U.S. Senate Foreign Relations Committee



Havana, September 20 (RHC)-- Cuban Foreign Minister Bruno Rodríguez met Wednesday in Havana with U.S. Senator Robert Corker, Chairman of the Foreign Relations Committee of the U.S. Senate.
