

Santiago residents pay tribute to Fidel



Santiago de Cuba, December 4 (RHC)-- Residents of Santiago de Cuba paid tribute to the historic leader of the Cuban Revolution, Fidel Castro on Tuesday morning, two years to the day when his ashes were interred at the city's Santa Ifigenia Cemetery.
