

Climate study finds ocean temperatures hit record high in 2018



Washington, January 21 (RHC)-- In climate news, a new study finds Earth's oceans reached their warmest temperature in recorded history in 2018 -- an ominous sign that greenhouse gas emissions are fueling rising seas and ever more powerful storms.

The analysis published in the journal *Advances in Atmospheric Sciences* finds ocean warming has accelerated sharply since the 1990s, at a pace that's much faster than previously recognized.
