

World Leaders Gather in The Hague to Discuss Prevention of Nuclear Terrorism



The Hague, March 24 (RHC)-- World leaders gathered in The Hague in the Netherlands on Monday to discuss the prevention of nuclear terrorism.

UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon addressed the opening session of the two-day Nuclear Security Summit to be attended by over 50 world leaders.

The summit is aimed at ensuring effective global cooperation to prevent terrorists getting hold of nuclear weapons or material.

The first Nuclear Security Summit was held in Washington D.C. in 2010 following a speech made by United States President Barack Obama warning about the dangers of nuclear terrorism.
