

28th International Book Fair in full swing



Havana, February 11 (RHC)-- The 28th International Book Fair, scheduled in Havana until February 17th, is in full swing.

According to organizers of the annual fair, more than 10 titles are being presented by the National Organization of Collective Law Firms. *Law and Law: Management of legal conflicts by collective of authors*, and *Control of constitutionality of legal rules. An approach to the Cuban model*, by Yumil Rodríguez Fernánde, stand out.
