

President Nicolás Maduro congratulates Cubans on Sunday's referendum



Caracas, February 25 (RHC)-- Venezuelan president Nicolás Maduro on Monday congratulated the Cuban government and people on the referendum held Sunday islandwide on a new Constitution, after a long process marked by transparency and people's active participation.
