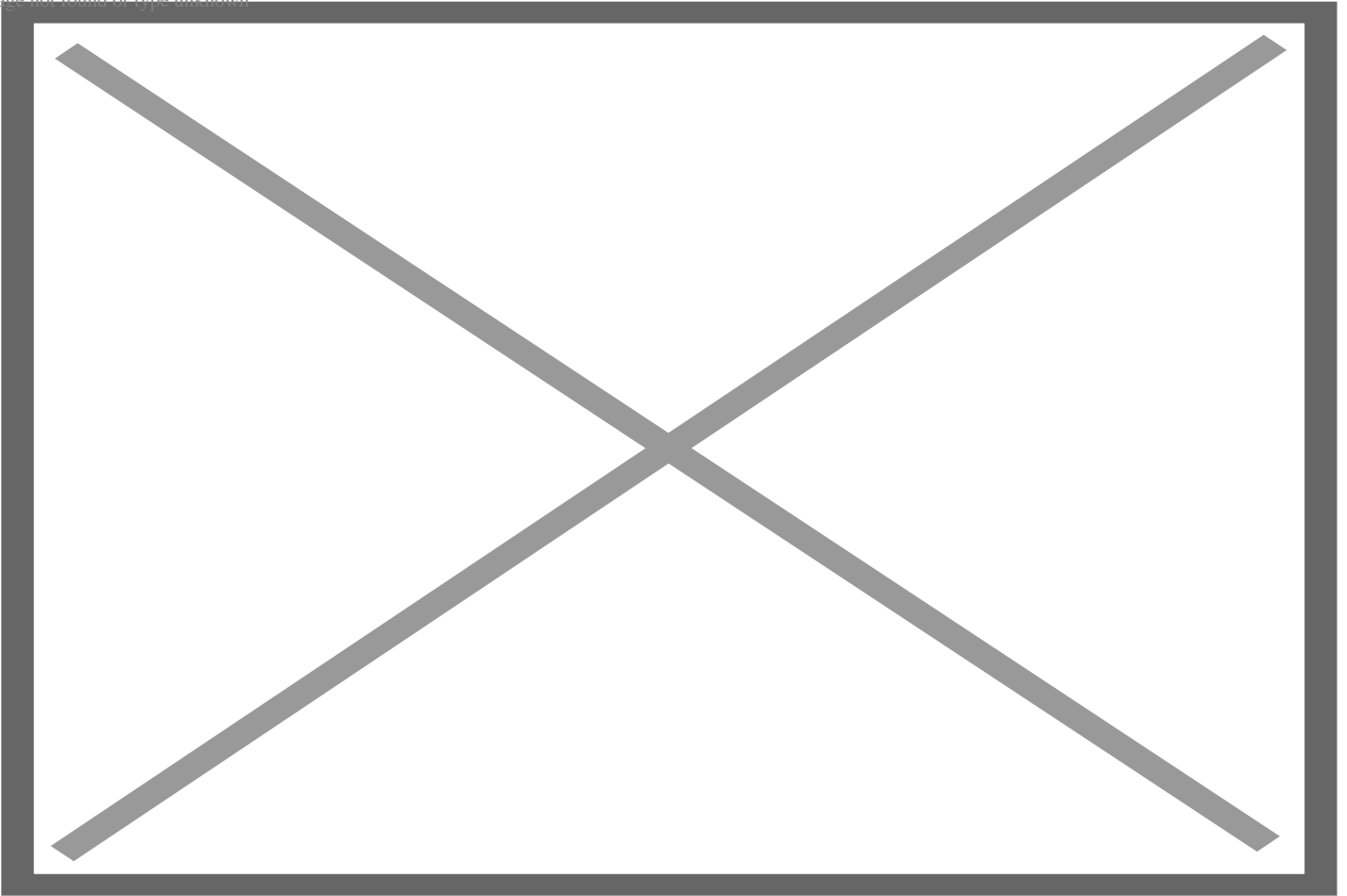


Raul Castro: Cuba needs of women's strength to progress
