

Cuban president talks with leaders of Kenya and Somalia on kidnapped Cuban doctors



Havana, April 18 (RHC)-- Cuban President Miguel Díaz-Canel has spoken with his Kenyan counterparts, Uhuru Kenyatta, and Somalia, Mohamed Abdullahi Mohamed, about two kidnapped Cuban doctors, Assel Herrera and Landy Rodríguez.

In a Tweet, Díaz-Canel recently noted that Cuba is working tirelessly for the safe return of collaborators kidnapped in Kenya on April 12.
