

Next edition of Caribbean Festival will be dedicated to Uruguay



Santiago de Cuba, April 23 (RHC)—The 39th edition of the Caribbean Festival will be held from July 3 to 9 and will be dedicated to Uruguay.

Eduardo Lorier Sandro, ambassador of Uruguay in Cuba, said in the event's hostess city, Santiago de Cuba, that his country will send a broad and enthusiastic delegation made up of intellectuals and artists from different manifestations, such as music, painting and dance.
