

Iran and Cuba interested in boosting trade and investments



Tehran, May 13 (RHC)—The president of Iran's Chamber of Commerce, Industries, Mine and Agriculture, Gholamhossein Shafei, said that his country is willing to promote business and investments in Cuba, Prensa Latina reports.

During an encounter with Alexis Bandrich, Cuban ambassador to Iran, Shafei voiced his country's commitment to resume its participation in Havana's International Trade Fair this year.
