Expo Caribe will provide opportunity to encourage foreign investment



Havana, May 27 (RHC)-- Expo Caribe trade fair is returning to Santiago de Cuba, after a hiatus of 11 years. The Heredia Theater exhibit grounds will host the event from June 19 to 22.

This year's edition is expected to be ideal for the promotion of goods and firms from all over the island, especially those from Camaguey and the eastern provinces. It also seeks to strengthen trade ties with neighboring Caribbean nations.

The resumption of the fair, the second largest of its type in the country, responds to a government's strategy of reinforcing ties with the Caribbean region.
