

Huge demonstrations in solidarity with Venezuela held in cities around the world



Caracas, August 11 (RHC)-- Around the world on Saturday, massive demonstrations took place to protest the latest maneuvers by U.S. imperialism to destroy the Bolivarian Revolution of Venezuela and take control of its resources.

In Venezuela, students, workers, public officials, police and military personnel marched together in rejection of the U.S. economic blockade against Venezuela.

Venezuela's Great Patriotic Pole (GPP) and the Bolivarian Congress of Peoples held a demonstration on World Protest Day Saturday against the economic, financial and commercial blockade imposed by U.S. President Donald Trump on this South American country.

Carrying national flags and wearing red sport hats, thousands began to gather early in the morning at squares and other public places. They then took to the streets of Caracas, the Venezuelan capital, to protest against U.S. President Donald Trump.

Dozens of countries took part in the World Protest Day under the hashtags, #NoMoreTrump, #NoMasTrump and #HandsOffVenezuela in support of Venezuela and the Bolivarian Revolution.

Demonstrators in Australia, U.S., France, Aruba, South Korea, Haiti, Turkey Italy, Germany, Dominican Republic, Argentina, and Mozambique, among other nations, protested Saturday, demanding the U.S. administration halt their illegal and inhuman blockade on Venezuela and end their tactics to try and install their puppet and self-declared interim president, Juan Guaido.
