

Cuban leaders attend the 30th-anniversary celebration of “Solidarity with Panama” Special School



Havana, December 21 (RHC)-- Army General Raul Castro, First Secretary of the Communist Party, and Miguel Diaz-Canel, President of the Republic of Cuba, attended this Friday night the celebration for the 30th anniversary of the school Solidarity with Panama.

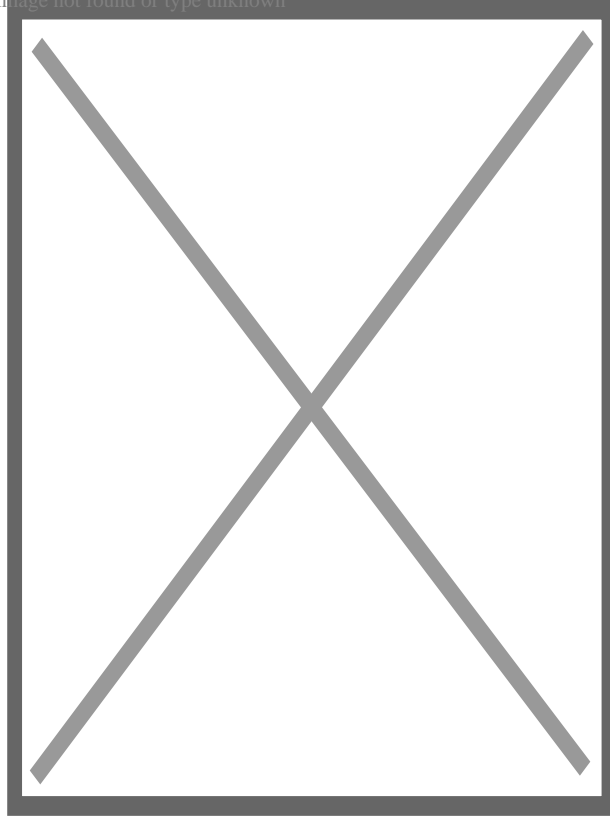
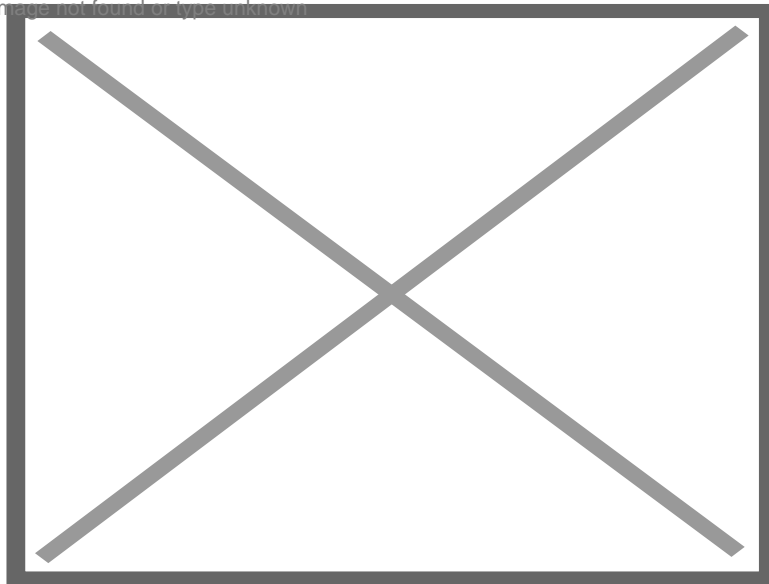
