Donald Trump contradicts WHO's warning over coronavirus death rate



Washington, March 5 (RHC)-- The World Health Organization announced that the global death rate from the disease caused by the new coronavirus is 3.4% — far deadlier than the seasonal flu. But the very next day, President Donald Trump said he had a "hunch" the number was actually much lower.

Trump was speaking with Fox News's Sean Hannity. He said: "Well, I think the 3.4% is really a false number. Now, this is just my hunch, and — but based on a lot of conversations with a lot of people that do this, because a lot of people will have this, and it's very mild."
