Osleni Guerrero debuts with a win in Jamaica



Havana, (RHC) - Osleni Guerrero made his debut today with a 2-0 win at the VI International Badminton Tournament in Jamaica, which will run until the 8th and awards 2500 points to the winners of each modality.

Guerrero dominated the local Willroy Miles with identical 21-13 splits in 34 minutes, but will face tonight in the second round the Japanese Takuma Obayashi, difficult commitment if you consider that any opponent from that country is always a tough challenge, especially ranked 132 in the world.

Last Monday in the Jamaican capital of Kingston, the Japanese had in 20 minutes and with segments of 21-3 and 21-4 of the also inexperienced host Mattew Yee-Grant (3003).

Osleni, on the other hand, was in the place 85 of the list of the orb at the moment to choose to the seeded ones to conform the organizational chart or the draw of this match, and its initial opponent in 3000.

To advance to the quarterfinals, El Guerrero will have to bring out all his weapons tonight, which obviously does not lie only in his physical strength, although this is an important element.

If he beats the Japanese, he will have another serious opponent tomorrow, which could be Ade Resky Dwicahyo from Azerbaijan, 76 in the world ranking, who is the favourite to beat Hungary's Gergely Krausz

(111), but better to wait for what happens in the second round today.

Meanwhile the first in the seed, the Guatemalan Kevin Cordon, was bye in the opening and should not have problems to eliminate the home Matthew Lee (1579), who won by no introduction of American Timothy Lam (105).

Also making his debut in the second round will be Canada's Brian Yang (62 and second seed) against Portugal's Bernardo Antillano (145), who has been a victim of American Mathew Fogarty (870) with scores of 21-7 and 21-8.
