

May Day Has Special Significance for the Cuban People



Havana, April 29 (RHC) – The General Secretary of the Confederation of Cuban Workers, Ulises Guilarte, said that Cubans stage the largest annual demonstration in the country on May Day, and this year they all have important motivations, since International Workers' Day has a special significance for all Cubans.

Guilarte, who is also member of the Communist Party's Central Committee, said that the march will take place amidst celebrations for the 75th anniversary of the workers' organization and after its 20th Congress.

The trade union leader said that Cuban workers are the protagonists of the current update of the country's economic model as they are involved in efforts towards efficiency.
