Cuba and the European Union Continue Negotiations in Havana



Havana, April 30 (RHC) -- In Havana on Wednesday, Cuba and the European Union continue conversations towards political dialog and cooperation accord, according to diplomatic sources.

The negotiations aim at contributing to the normalization of relations between the European bloc and the Caribbean island. The recent visit to Cuba by French foreign minister, Laurent Fabius, expressed a new vision towards Cuba, according to experts. Fabius held a long meeting with President Raul Castro.
