Vivir para vencer: a song by Arnaldo y su Talisman for May Day



Havana, April 23 (RHC) -- Arnaldo Rodríguez y su Talisman has composed a song to celebrate May Day, International Workers' Day. The initiative is from the National Culture Workers Union, at the proposal of General Secretary, Nereyda Labrada. Vivir para vencer or 'Live to win,' recorded at the Egrem studios, was co-authored by Arnaldo Rodríguez himself and Alfredo Felipe for the occasion.
