

Spain to open borders to EU Schengen countries on June 21st



Madrid, June 15 (RHC)-- Spain will open its borders to countries in the European Union's Schengen area on June 21st, except for Portugal where the border will open on July 1 as previously announced, Spanish media reported.

The Spanish government had previously said it would allow foreign tourists to enter Spain on July 1 without self-quarantining, apart from the Balearic Islands which could start receiving tourists on Monday as part of a test program.

Spanish Prime Minister Pedro Sanchez says he will ask Spain's Parliament for a final two-week extension. Tourism in Spain has been hit hard by the pandemic
