

The threat of President Donald Trump



There are deep concerns in certain political sectors of the United States for the reaction of President Donald Trump, who tries in every way to disqualify the elections next November, now that polls indicate that he could lose against his rival, Joe Biden.

This position is held by John Ratcliffe, a close friend of Trump.

However, Robert Bauer, Joe Biden's advisor, declared: "We assume that (Donald Trump) can resort to any kind of trick, strategy or plan to maintain the presidency. We have created a solid program to consider all possibilities and ensure he won't be successful."
