

Fast-Food Workers in More than 30 Countries Stage One-Day Strike



New York, May 15 (RHC)-- Thousands of fast-food workers staged a one-day strike today in at least 150 cities across the United States and in more than 30 countries around the world.

Workers are demanding the right to organize and calling for a doubling of their wages from the current minimum wage of \$7.25 an hour to \$15 an hour.

Organizers with Fast Food Forward say the actions for better salaries and working conditions have spread to fast food restaurants throughout the world.
