

France again registers over 7,000 new COVID-19 infections



Paris, September 3 (RHC)-- France has registered more than 7,000 new coronavirus infections over 24 hours for the second time in two days, the health ministry said, just shy of a 7,578 record set on March 31, while hospitalisations for the virus also rose again.

The health ministry reported that the cumulative total of confirmed cases rose to 300,181, up by 7,157. It had reported an increase of 7,017 cases on Wednesday.

The number of people in intensive care with the disease in France also rose again for the fifth consecutive day, up by 18 to 464.
