

Chinese Chief of Staff Visits Cuba



Havana, May 19 (RHC) -- The Chief of Staff of the Chinese Army, General Fang Fenghui, who is heading a military delegation on a two-day official visit to Cuba, paid tribute to Cuban Independence hero, Antonio Maceo on Sunday here in Havana.

Accompanied by the member of the Political Bureau of Cuba's Communist Party and First Deputy Minister of the Revolutionary Armed Forces, General Alvaro Lopez Miera, the Chinese high-ranking officer toured a tank unit and laid a wreath at the mausoleum treasuring the remains of the Cuban patriot.

The Chinese military delegation is also made up of Vice Admiral Xiu Hongmeng, deputy chief of the Chinese Navy and by Lieutenant General Ma Zhenjung, chief of staff of the Air Force. The visitors were welcomed at the Rescate de Sanguily and Order Antonio Maceo Tank Unit by its chief, Brigadier General Rafael Ignacio Borjas.
