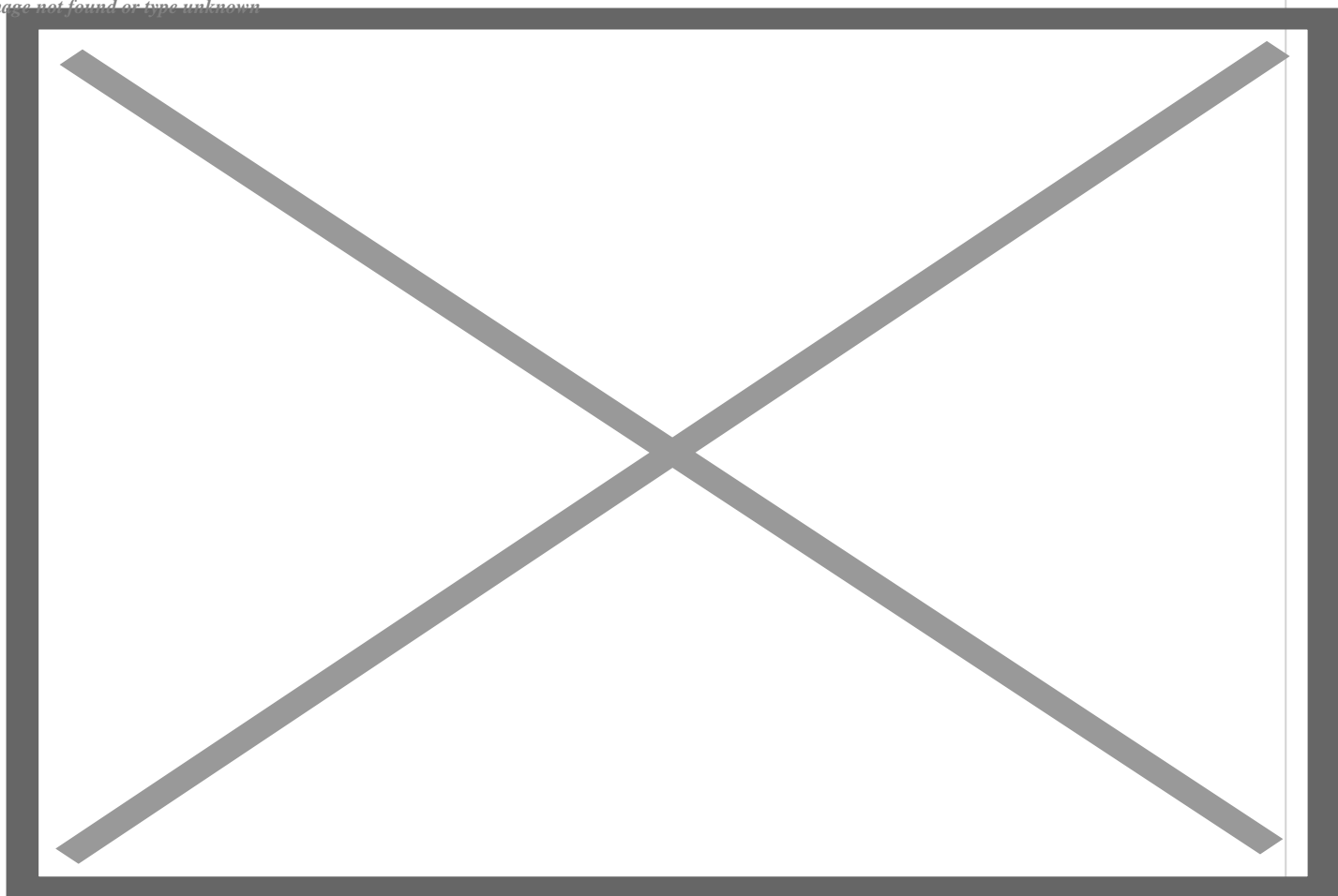


Book of condolences for the death of Syrian foreign minister opened in Cuba
