

Cuba reports 838 new cases, 4 deaths



Havana, February 22 (RHC)-- Cuba reported on Monday 838 new COVID-19 infections and 4 deaths in the last 24 hours.

The National Chief of Epidemiology, Dr. Francisco Duran said that 18,960 tests were carried out to detect the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, the cause of the pandemic.

Since the beginning of the epidemic, 45,361 people have been infected with COVID-19 and 300 have died.

Havana reported 412 cases on Sunday. Santiago de Cuba followed with 87, and Mayabeque with 72.
