Caracas, March 28 (RHC)-- Executive Vice President Delcy Rodriguez expressed her appreciation on behalf of Venezuela for the efforts of the World Health Organization (WHO) to distribute vaccines against

COVID-19 through the COVAX mechanism, which will add to the vaccination process developed by the Bolivarian Government.
