

Cuba reports 1,029 new COVID-19 infections and two deaths



Havana, April 3 (RHC) -- Cuba reported two deaths and 1,029 new infections of Covid-19 over the last 24 hours.

Cuba currently accumulates 78,382 COVID-19 infections and 431 deaths since March 2020.

In his daily briefing to the nation on Saturday morning, Dr. Francisco Duran, the island's Chief Epidemiologist informed that among the new cases there were 159 minors, 147 in pediatric age, with 6 infants.

Havana reported 570 cases, Matanzas province ranked second with 100 followed by Santiago de Cuba with 80

This has been a record-breaking week, with some 6 thousand cases.
